

Doubting?

Plead to God!

“My heart is confident in you, O God; no wonder I can sing your praises with all my heart!” King David in Psalm 108 (NLT)

I've read this Psalm potentially 20-30 times over the years. Why is it that it wasn't until this last time that this question came to me: **“Is my heart confident in God?”** My first answer, “Of course!” God immediately challenged me, “Show me.” I created a list of the behaviors of a confident heart: Sure, Expectant, Joyful, Excited, Trusting, Calm, Steadfast, Without worry or doubt, Full of love, Patient.... Ouch! I failed the challenge. God has a way of pointing out our weaknesses and it's very humbling.

“Could I ever aspire to have such confidence in God as King David?” After all, God chose him because he was a man after his own heart. God knew he would do whatever he wanted him to do. **But, I seem to have doubts all of the time!**

I read further....After declaring his confidence, David proceeds to worship God and then he asks him to rescue his people. David reminds God that he has already promised to do this. But then he writes,

*"Who will bring me into the fortified city?
Who will bring me victory over Edom?
11 Have you rejected us, O God?
Will you no longer march with our armies?
12 Oh, please help us against our enemies,
for all human help is useless." Psalm 108:10-12*

David pleads to God. Is this the voice of someone with a confident heart?! David sure doesn't sound calm, patient, and without doubt. I asked God, "What's with the disconnect?" Long pause..... Then I reread the last phrase David wrote,

*"With God's help we will do mighty things,
for he will trample down our foes." Psalm 108:13*

David comes full circle. He recommits his heart by reaffirming his faith in the Lord. David knew that...

*"... it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him."
Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)*
